



Techniques and Tools for Adaptation Metrics

Challenges in Adaptation Metrics:

- Complexity of systems/interactions and variable needs
- Not just physical: +social, economic, political, cultural
- Lack of standards and know-how on what to measure, how to measure it
- Data availability and quality are big problems
- Insufficient tools and variable know-how on how to make decisions about the future - foresight
- Choosing appropriate metrics and communicating to different stakeholders





Techniques and Tools for Adaptation Metrics

More Challenges in Adaptation Metrics:

- Lack of mechanisms to instrumentalize metrics for project, investment, and policy
 - How effectively identify needs?
 - How to enable metrics to incentivize appropriate, sustainable adaptations?
 - How to evaluate metrics qualities for and communicate metrics appropriately to end users?
 - How to harmonize metrics across sectors, disciplines, and cultures?
- Standards and regulations: what <u>needs</u> to be collected? which data <u>ought</u> to be collected? what level of governance?

These questions can only be addressed through appropriate harnessing of existing and emerging techniques and tools, and through the creation and adoption of new ones!



Techniques and Tools for Adaptation Metrics



Techniques and tools rapidly evolving:

- Data and analytical tools (Blockchain, Internet of Things, Machine Learning, etc.)
- Decision Sciences (modeling, futures literacy, scenario planning)
- Social Sciences (community consultation, surveying techniques....and ways of knowing what counts)
- Business and government (practices and resources ... insurance, census, etc.)
- Art and civil society (literature, street art, demonstration, social media)

Techniques and Tools: what is needed?

- Merge and add new approaches to each discipline's "tool kit" for:
 surveilling archiving sharing evaluating co-developing and piloting
- Encouraging innovation and quality improvements to:
 data foresight metrics monitoring approaches evaluations and decision making
- Encourage trans-disciplinary perspectives and also "fill in" for extra topics not covered by committees

3. Adaptation Metrics Mapping and Evaluation (AMME)

AMME Work Program

AMME Objectives:

- Support practitioners, funders, policymakers and research community
- to identify, deploy, and build on existing and emerging adaptation metrics.

Program Approach:

- Strong "user need" framework: informs evaluation framework
- Projects defined/led (mainly) by committees
- Modular framework: projects may be broken down to meet funder/user priorities within a coherent, harmonized approach



AMME Phases

Phase 1: Mapping/Evaluating

- Definitions
- User purposes/standards required
- Survey of metrics, positioning/evaluating metrics
- Define tools and techniques required for metrics creation and use

International Platform on Adaptation Metrics

Phase 2 - Creation of an open source tool:

- Geographic database for data collection from ongoing projects
- Metrics generation and use from data to modelling
- Capacity building and metrics sharing

AMME: Structure and Next Steps


- Further articulate AMME structure and process
- Identify organizations interested in supporting initiative: seeking multi-stakeholder support to strengthen buy-in and expert/financial resource-base
- Share work program defined projects' concept with interested supporters to refine concept and secure funding
- Trans-committee driven initiative
 for strong connection with sectoral experts and users + tool
 builders
- Regular updates on project progress
 to broader IPAM/stakeholder community





AMME for Techniques and Tools: Project options and ideas

- Inventory existing and proposed tools
- Explore potential of approaches/ technologies including engagement with:
 - technical experts (creation)
 - end-users (feedback loop)
- Support sectoral committees in deploying appropriate tools
- Integrate tools/techniques across disciplines
- Communicate/disseminate tools to relevant stakeholders
- Build capacity to effectively deploy tools
 - Training
 - Uptake by decision-makers
- Other ideas?


